

FEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE

You are responsible for cleaning your room and apartment and ensuring that upon inspection or check out it stays in the same condition as it was upon check in; fair wear and tear excepted. If cleaning is required the cost will depend on the area to be cleaned e.g. twin room, studio, bathroom, kitchen and the level of cleaning required. If any items or areas were damaged during your stay you will be responsible for the cost of repairing or replacing them. Damages and cleaning charges in communal areas will be divided equally among all occupants.

If the charges are applied on check out the cost or partial cost will be deducted from your bond.

The costs below are a guide only. Costs may change dependent on the specification of some items in your property. urbanest will only pass on the actual cost of replacement or repairs to you.

Repairs and/or replacement - communal areas & kitchen

Smoking

Fire alarm fees

If you are responsible for setting off the fire alarm in your room/apartment the charge will be passed on to you. The fire brigade charge a fee per truck for the time spent on site. These fees are different in each state. The exact cost will be confirmed when the invoice is issued by the fire brigade.
